EXPLORATORY SPANISH – 6TH GRADE DURATION: 36 WEEKS

At the beginning level, students start their study of language with a focus on the of proficiency in listening and speaking skills with reading and writing integrated later. Students will use basic language to interact with their peers about familiar topics. They are able to understand commands, key words and phrases, and they can make inferences from materials they hear or read with help of visual cues. Grammar is taught contextually.

At this level, students can work well from patterns and facts, but they have difficulty making applications. They need explicit practice with a model. Teachers will want to stress similarities, rather than differences, especially when dealing with culture.

As speaking is major objective for this level, it is imperative that speaking assessments, both formal and informal, are done regularly.
